The Hambden Township Trustees met in Executive Session at the Hambden Town Hall on Wednesday, May 17, 2017 at 6:00 p.m. with the following members present: Scott Yamamoto, Keith McClintock and Edward Kaminski. RESOLUTION 2017-056: Made by Keith McClintock, seconded by Edward Kaminski to move into executive session to discuss and interview John F. Kennedy for summer seasonal employment with the township. Upon call of roll: Mr. McClintock – yes, Mr. Kaminski – yes and Mr. Yamamoto - yes. Motion carried.

The Board of Trustees reviewed the application on John F. Kennedy and went over his qualifications for the summer seasonal position with the township.

The rate will be increased to \$17.00 per hour, upon Mr. Kennedy fulfilling the state requirements in obtaining his CDL. Upon call of roll: Mr. McClintock – yes, Mr. Kaminski – yes and Mr. Yamamoto - yes. Motion carried.

Mrs. Chorman will notify Mr. Kennedy of the Boards' offer and apprise the Board of his response. If Mr. Kennedy accepts, his pre-employment drug test will be scheduled as soon as possible.
