Regular Meeting
October 11, 2022

Hambden Parks and Recreation Board met in regular session on October 11, 2022 at 6:00 p.m. in Hambden Township Hall. The following members were present: Joyce Edelinsky, Jim Petkosek, Steve Marks, John Janor and Linda Petkosek. Also present was Trustee Pam Carson.

OLD BUSINESS

Storm water Basin – Fall Landscape Installation – Future Landscaping Grant Info. We received two quotes for the fall landscape installation. The trustees approved the quote from Wiley. Trustee Carson reported that Trustee McClintock thought that future landscaping projects could fall under "Improvements to the Park." The Geauga Parks Foundation Grant for a Pollination Garden for this year is due November 4th. Due to the time frame the board felt it would be better to wait and apply in the spring to allow the board to gather the information for the grant. With the information we already have from Bob Zenz and possible assistance from Wiley we should be able to obtain the information we need for the grant.

Pavilion #4 Roof – No report at this time. Mr. Molan is going to refine the repairs for the roof before we rebid.

Dugout Mural – Mr. Marks has a possible contact for the dugout mural. He will continue to follow-up with contacting them. Elliott Miller is the artist doing the murals for the City of Chardon. He will try to make contact to see if he would be a possibility for the dugout.

Memorial Pavers – Mrs. Edelinsky gave an update to the new members on what needs to be done with the Memorial Walkway. Mrs. Edelinsky asked Mrs. Petkosek to follow up with contacts on finding someone to do the brick inscriptions.

Wood Jungle Gym/Slide – Mrs. Edelinsky reported on her conversation with Bob Smetana. They discussed a platform to incorporate the two slides but his project manager felt it could be a liability. They will continue discussion on this project.

NEW BUSINESS

Pavilion Info Boxes – Mrs. Edelinsky asked the Petkoseks' to check out what would be available for new information boxes in the pavilions for next spring over the winter.
