

Hambden Parks and Recreation Board  
Regular Meeting  
June 14, 2022

Hambden Parks and Recreation Board met in regular session on June 14, 2022 at 5:30 p.m. in Hambden Township Hall. The following members were present: Joyce Edelinsky, Jim Petkosek and Linda Petkosek. Also present was Trustee Pam Carson.

**Minutes:** Motion by Mrs. Petkosek, second by Mr. Petkosek to approve the May 17, 2022 minutes as presented. Upon call of vote, all yes.

**OLD BUSINESS**

**Storm water Basin – Landscape Installation** – Wiley was the only bid for the landscape installation for the detention pond. To bring the cost down, the board agreed to reduce the number of ornamental grass plantings. Mrs. Carson will talk to him about adjusting the price for that. He would prefer a fall planting but Mrs. Edelinsky stated that we prefer to have it done before the township picnic. The township will be responsible for the watering of the plants. Mrs. Carson will take the board's preferences to the next trustees meeting.

**Dugout mural** – no new information at this time.

**Tvergyak Water Run Off** – It was reported that there is standing water on the walking path again by the Tvergyak property even though we have had little rain. We will continue monitoring the situation.

**Pavilion #4 Roof** – We received one bid for the pavilion #4 roof. The bid came in higher than expected and without additional bids it was difficult to do a comparison. It was recommended that we wait until this fall or next spring to rebid.

**Movie Night** – Movie night will be July 30<sup>th</sup>. To stay within covid protocols we will hand out prepackaged snacks and bottles of water. Fire Chief Hildenbrand has ok'd the use of the fire department lights for that night. This information will be included in the township newsletter.

**NEW BUSINESS**

**Park Info Boards** – Mrs. Petkosek will follow through on updating the board with the information she found.

**Dugout Storage sheds/painting** – The township workers will paint the storage sheds. It was also reported the shed by field #3 needs sprayed for carpenter bees. Mrs. Edelinsky stated to also spray the yellow tops on the playground equipment.

**Park Board Member Position Description** – The members discussed the position description. There are certain areas they felt could be reworded or eliminated but decided to leave as it for now.

**Park Board Candidates** – Mrs. Carson has interviewed two candidates for new park board members. She will take her recommendations to the next trustees meeting.

There being no further business to come before the board, motion by Mrs. Edelinsky, second by Mrs. Petkosek to adjourn the meeting at 6:40 p.m. **Next meeting** will be scheduled for July 12, 2022 at a time convenient for all members.
