OLD BUSINESS

Storm water Basin – Fall Landscape Installation – Continued discussion on the landscape installation of the storm water basin. We will place a limit on the amount that can be spent for plants to avoid any prevailing wage conflicts. The Trustees would like to see additional quotes for comparison. There were several contractors mentioned by the park board members that may be interested in bidding on the project. They will be contacted and hopefully be able to continue with the bidding process this fall.

Tvergyak Water Run Off – No report.

Pavilion #4 Roof – Mrs. Edelinsky will be checking with Mr. Molan on revamping the specs for pavilion #4 roof. We would like to see this project bid for this fall.

Dug Out Mural – No report

Movie Night – There were approximately 75 people that attended movie night. We will do again next year if we receive funding for it.

Park Info Boards – Ms. Petkosek suggested that within the next couple years we replace the information boxes in pavilions #1 and 2 so that the information can be changed more often. Right now you have to actually take the box apart to add or change anything in them.

Community Picnic wrap up – Pam and Joyce thanked everyone for their help with the picnic. Suggestions for next year were better signage for the raffles, face painting and trying to obtain Jungle Terry for the event.

NEW BUSINESS

CBL Baseball Fields Usage – Mrs. Edelinsky reported that in speaking with the president of the Chardon Baseball League they have projected using our baseball fields possibly for the next ten years. They will continue maintaining the fields which will be an asset to the township.

Park Tree – Hometown Tree Service removed the dead tree in the park.

Tot Swing – The tot swings have been removed until they can be replaced next spring. The swings were damaged when a child of inappropriate age and size used the swing and had to be removed by the fire department.
